Explanatory note for applicants
applying for renewal of limited registration under Promulgation No. 3

To apply for renewal of limited registration, the applicant is required to provide the following documents :-

1. a completed application form with self-declaration (Note A);
2. an official letter from his/her employing institution certifying that his/her qualifications meet the criteria for limited registration under section 14A of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Cap. 161, and that hi/her appointment is necessary and appropriate to meet the community's need for medical service and/or training.
3. a notarised copy of his/her passport or Hong Kong Identity Card (Note B)
4. a crossed cheque or banker's draft for **HK\$1,450*** made payable to "**The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region**" (香港特別行政區政府)
(HK\$1,100 being registration fee and HK\$350 being fee for a practising certificate)

Note A: Applicants are warned that it is a criminal offence punishable by imprisonment to make a false declaration, and they must ensure the accuracy of all information provided.

Note B: If the applicant submits his/her application in person, he/she may choose to produce the original (together with a photocopy) of his/her passport or Hong Kong Identity Card, instead of the notarised copy.
