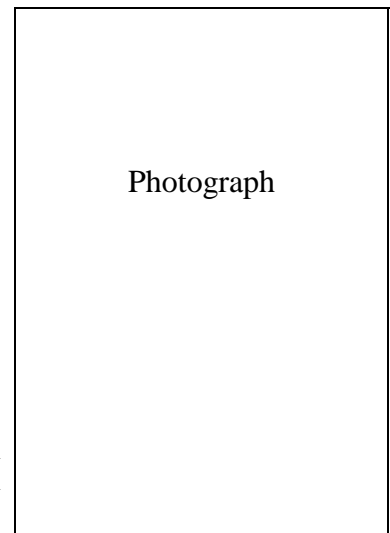

Explanatory note for applicants applying for limited registration under Promulgation No. 4

Pursuant to section 14A of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Chapter 161, Laws of Hong Kong, the Medical Council of Hong Kong has determined that until such time as it may take a contrary determination the following employment is appropriate and necessary for limited registration under the Ordinance:-

“Being such persons (whose names were entered prior to the end of 1964 into a list maintained by the Registrar of Clinics, Department of Health and who are or who have been registered under Promulgation No. 3 of the Medical Council of Hong Kong on Limited Registration) appointed for the provision of primary healthcare, and to be responsible for the medical management of those clinics registered under the Medical Clinics Ordinance, Chapter 343 of the Laws of Hong Kong.”

Persons registered as medical practitioners with limited registration under promulgation no. 4 shall be subject to the following restrictions and conditions regarding their practice:-

- (1) the Professional Code and Conduct for the Guidance of Registered Medical Practitioners, published by the Council; and
- (2) the Code of Practice for Medical Practitioners Registered with Limited Registration in accordance with Promulgation No. 4, published by the Council.

To apply for limited registration, an applicant is required to provide the following documents:-

1. a completed application form with declaration (Note A);
2. an official letter from his/her employer/employing institution certifying that the applicant has been appointed for the provision of primary healthcare and he is responsible for the medical management of a clinic registered under the Medical Clinics Ordinance, Cap. 343 and that his/her appointment is necessary and appropriate to meet the community's need for medical service (the name chop of the employing institution has to be stamped on the official letter.)
3. a notarized copy of his/her passport or Hong Kong Identity Card (Note B);
4. three copies of the applicant's photograph of a size not greater than 50 x 70 mm and not less than 40 x 60 mm; and
5. a crossed cheque or banker's draft for **HK\$1,450*** made payable to “**The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region**” (香港特別行政區政府) (HK\$1,100* being registration fee and HK\$350* being fee for a practising certificate)

Note A : Applicants are warned that it is a criminal offence punishable by imprisonment to make a false declaration, and they must ensure the accuracy of all information provided.

Note B : If the applicant submits his/her application in person, he/she may choose to produce the original (together with a photocopy) of his/her passport or Hong Kong Identity Card, instead of the notarized copy.
