

Use of personal data

The personal data given to the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board will be used to implement the provisions of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance.

Transfer of personal data

The personal data you provide are mainly for use within the Council, but they may also be disclosed to other Government bureaux/departments, agencies or authorities for the purpose mentioned in paragraph 29. The public can have access to the personal data of registered Chinese medicine practitioners, including the names and addresses, etc. published in the list of registered Chinese medicine practitioners in the Gazette and the homepage of the Chinese Medicine Council. Apart from these, your other personal data will only be disclosed where you have given consent to such disclosure or where such disclosure is permitted by the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance.

Correction of personal data

Applicants/listed Chinese medicine practitioners/registered Chinese medicine practitioners have the right of access and correction with respect to personal data as provided for in sections 18 and 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance. A fee may be imposed for complying with a data access request. Should there be any amendment to the personal data, the applicants/listed Chinese medicine practitioners/registered Chinese medicine practitioners should notify the Secretariat in writing as soon as possible.
