
Olympic and Paralympic Events from August to September 2008

You may be aware that the Olympic and Paralympic Equestrian Events will soon be carried out in Hong Kong. We anticipate large numbers of competition teams and spectators from all over the world will be arriving in Hong Kong. To this end, the Government has organized designated medical and health services for participants of these Events.

To better advise the public or other potential spectators of the Equestrian Event, the Department of Health has published the "Health Tips for Spectators" (available at: <http://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/DH-Equestrian.pdf>). Since we have also entered the summer influenza season, please be reminded to report any suspected outbreaks or other infectious diseases of public health concern.

Notifications can be made to Central Notification Office (CENO) through phone (2477 2772) or fax (2477 2770) or CENO online (<http://www.chp.gov.hk/ceno>). The DH on duty Medical Control Officers will screen incoming fax and voice messages left at CENO during weekends and public holidays. If urgent attention is considered required by the notifying doctors, such as cases that are severe and fatal, widespread transmission has occurred, rare cases in Hong Kong, cases that may be related to deliberate release, you may contact CENO during office hours, or, when notification is made outside office hours, contact Medical Control Officer at 71163300 call 9179.
