## Application for Restoration of Name to the Register of Radiographers under section 10(5) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance

To safeguard public health and maintain the professionalism of radiographers, the Radiographers Board has decided to adopt the following new arrangement with effect from  $1\,May\,2017$  –

- Applicant, who applies for restoration after 3 years or more from the expiry date of his / her last practising certificate, should submit evidence to show that he / she has equipped himself / herself with updated professional knowledge and skills to practise radiography during the removal period. Applicant would have to attain 15 or more continuing professional development (CPD) credits accredited by the Board within 3 years prior to the date of the restoration application before the applications would be approved;
- Applicants should complete the new application form as attached, accompanied by a statutory declaration made before a Commissioner for Oaths or Notary Public as to the truthfulness of the contents of the application form.

## The Radiographers Board of Hong Kong **Application for Restoration of Name to the Register of Radiographers**

I wish to apply to the Radiographers Board of Hong Kong for the restoration of my name to the register of radiographers in accordance with section 10(5) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance, Chapter 359, Laws of Hong Kong.

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- (a) During any period when my name had been removed from the register of radiographers,
  - (i) I have / have not\* practised radiography in Hong Kong; and
  - (ii) I have / have not\* practised radiography in an overseas country [Note 2]; and

Applicant who applies for restoration after 3 years or more from the expiry date of his / her last practising certificate should also submit evidence of having attained 15 or more continuing professional development (CPD) credits accredited by the Board within 3 years prior to the date of the restoration application before the application would be approved.
- Note 2: If the applicant has practised in an overseas country since his or her name was removed from the register of radiographers, this application must be supported by a certificate of good standing from the overseas statutory registration body which has jurisdiction over his or her latest practice. Any certificate issued for more than six months will not be accepted.
- Note 3: If it is in the affirmative, details must be attached to this application.
