Note 1 : The term 'registered address' in this form means the latest address supplied by you to the Registrar of Medical Practitioners for the purpose of registration. You may provide a residential address, a practising address or a post office box as your registered address.

Note 2 : Although the registered address may be a residential address, a practising address or a post office box number, the Medical Council advises registered medical practitioners to provide practising address as the registered address. The practising address will be of more meaningful for the public in ascertaining who is entitled to practise medicine in Hong Kong, and will also afford privacy to the practitioner's residential address.

Note 3 : As a mandatory requirement, registered addresses as well as names, qualifications and dates of qualifications of all persons whose names appear on the General Register and Specialist Register are required to be published annually in the Gazette.

Note 4 : While publication of the registered medical practitioner's registered address in the Gazette is a mandatory requirement under the Medical Registration Ordinance, the Medical Council has decided that a registered medical practitioner may choose whether to have your registered address published in the Council's website which is provided for the public to identify who is, or is not, registered as a medical practitioner or a specialist doctor. Any subsequent change in your choice must be notified in writing to the Registrar of Medical Practitioners, which will be incorporated in the website during the updating exercises. Requests for change of information in individual entries on the website will be processed during the updating exercises.
